- Your format **A paper should be no longer than one page**. Your **format B paper should be between 2 and 4 pages although occasionally papers up top 6 pages can be accepted**. Two complete pages represent a minimum length for the format B papers.

- Correct the format of authors' listing.

Your paper needs to be revised to meet GMEPE/PAHCE format requirements expected from us. Please, see format templates and samples.

- Do not include the conference headers and page numbers: conference headers and page numbers will be included by GMEPE/PAHCE Team during the proceedings preparation.

- Correct the title format: do not use only capital letters, neither only lowercase letters; title should combine both, according to the templates.

- Do not use italic in title, authors list, institutions' name, or abstract.

- Pay attention to the upper, lower, and side margins, indenting settings and setbacks; see templates.

- Papers should be loaded in a standard PDF format not as a scanned PDF image or other nonstandard

PDF format as it is not editable and the conference headings/footings cannot be incorporated

- Subtitles do not meet GMEPE/PAHCE format requirements expected from us. Please, see format templates and samples.

- Insert contact (email and phone) after the institutions' name.

- Do not use paragraphs in the Abstract

- Adjust the format of subsections: centralize the titles of the sections I, II, III , and References and use Roman numbers in titles; attention to the tabulation and setbacks; see templates for Format B papers.

- Papers written in Portuguese or Spanish must include English title before the Portuguese/Spanish title.

- Papers written in Portuguese or Spanish must include English Abstract/Keywords before their equivalent in Portuguese (Resumo/Palavras-chave) or Spanish (Resumen/Palabras claves).

- Correct the institutions' list and contact info.

- Your paper was not uploaded. Please, upload it in http://papersub.pahce.org/author/upload.php

- Insert contact (email and phone) after the institutions' name.
- Do not use paragraphs in the Abstract.

- Whenever all authors are bound to the same institution, it is not necessary to use the superscript index.

- Figure labels must start with "Fig. #." where "#" is the figure number.

- Use "Keywords" in place of "Index terms".

- Table names/labels do not meet GMEPE/PAHCE format requirements expected from us. Please, see format templates and samples.

- Correct the institutions' list and the superscript indexes.
- Insert Keywords after the Abstract, see templates.

- Do not include headers or footers: these areas should be empty in order to be filled by GMEPE/PAHCE Team during the proceedings preparation.

- Large figures and tables may span across both columns.

- Figure names/labels do not meet GMEPE/PAHCE format requirements expected from us. Please, see format templates and samples.

- **Do not use subsections** (Objective, Methodology, Conclusion, Acknowledgments :...) **in format A** papers.

- Include the list of authors and institutions.
- Include titles (labels) for the tables.

- References do not meet GMEPE/PAHCE format requirements expected from us. Please, see the format

of "References" section in templates and samples.

- Do not include figures or tables in format A papers, change to format B; see templates.

- Abstract missing. Include Abstract.

- Wrong letter type (all).
- Wrong size type in title. Use Times New Roman 14, bold.
- Wrong size of margins.
- Do not use A4 format.

- Include "Palabras claves".
- Figures should be referenced in the text.
- Tables should be referenced in the text.
- Abstract must be written in bold format.

- Equations do not meet GMEPE/PAHCE format requirements expected from us. Please, see format

templates and samples.

- Include a blank line between title and the list of authors.
- The first character in introduction is not appropriate.
- Use the terms 'Resumen' and 'Palabras claves' before the Introduction.
- Correct the format of Abstract/Keywords and Resumen/Palabras claves.
- Wrong size type (figure labels).
- Tables are mentioned in the text but not present in the paper.
- Once accepted, the article cannot have the list of authors changed.
